Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2017 capital budget Engineering Major Streets has budgeted \$7.89 million for the replacement of deteriorated roadways in the City via the Reconstruction Streets capital program (MUNIS 10226). The proposed resolution approves the contracts for the Gregory Street, Knickerbocker Street, Sprague Street and Sheldon Street Reconstruction Assessment District - 2017 at an estimated cost of \$3,521,470. This funding is provided by GO Borrowing.
