Fiscal Note

As stated in the Employment Agreement between the City of Madison and Christopher M. Kelley, the Streets Superintendent's initial year's salary will be based on a total annualized rate of \$127,391 effective April 23rd, 2017. The Streets Division's 2017 operating budget includes sufficient funding for the costs. Annual salary adjustments may be made during the term of the agreement at the Mayor's discretion, subject to Common Council approval.

WHEREAS, Mayor Soglin has appointed Christopher M. Kelley to the position of Streets Superintendent and has recommended to the Common Council that his appointment be confirmed; and
