#### **Fiscal Note**

In the adopted 2017 capital budget Engineering-Pedestrian/Bicycle has budgeted \$2.3 million for the repair and replacement of defective sidewalks within aldermanic districts 15 and 17 via the Sidewalk Program (MUNIS 10148). The proposed resolution awards the contract for the district 15 sidewalk improvements at a total estimated cost of \$793,960. Funding is provided by GO Borrowing and Special Assessments.
