### Fiscal Note

In the adopted 2017 capital budget the Water Utility has budgeted \$1.9 million for the reconstruction of the Lakeview Reservoir on the City's north side. The proposed resolution awards the contract for the Lakeview Reservoir improvements at a total cost of \$1,021,540. The funding for the Water Utility project is provided by revenue bonds. Associated street repair and stormwater utility maintenance costs totaling \$84,760 are also included in the contract, funded via GO Borrowing and Stormwater borrowing.
