### Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for water main replacement to Phase 6 of the Cannonball pipeline on the City's southwest side. The Water Utility's adopted 2017 capital budget includes reauthorized revenue bond funding within the Arbor Hills Fire Supply capital project for the work in this proposed work (MUNIS 10435). The estimated cost of the project phase is \$640,000.
