Fiscal Note

The proposed ordinance change reduces the number of late night vendors from two to one in zones located along University Avenue in the 300 block of N Frances Street and 400 block of West Gilman. Reducing the number of late night vendors in these zones will potentially result in a \$1,400 reduction in annual licensing revenue, which is budgeted in the General Fund.

\$200 basic Street Vending License x 2 = \$400
\$500 Late Night Vending License x 2 = \$1,000

Title

Amending Sections 9.13(6)(n)3.a. and b. of the Madison General Ordinances to change the number of late night vendors in Zones A and B from two to one vendor per zone.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance amendment reduces the number of vending sites available within Late Night Vending Zones A and B from two vendors in each zone to one vendor per zone. Zone A is on the west side of the 300 block of North Frances Street near the intersection with University Avenue, and Zone B is on the south side of the 400 block of West Gilman, also near University Avenue. The perimeters of these zones will not change, but the number of vendors who can be licensed to vend at night within Zones A and B will change from two to one vendor per zone.

The Common Council of the City of Madison do hereby ordain as follows:

Subparagraphs a. entitled "Zone A: 300 Block of North Frances" and b. entitled "Zone B: 400 Block of West Gilman" of Paragraph 3. entitled "Late Night Vending Areas" of Subdivision (n) entitled "Late Night Vending (LNV) Areas" of Subsection (6) entitled "Regulations and Procedures for Vending on the State Street Mall/Capitol Concourse" of Section 9.13 entitled "License For Selling on Public Streets" of the Madison

General Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

- "a. Zone A: 300 Block of North Frances. Zone A is located on the west side of the 300 block of North Frances Street as shown on the official LNV map approved by the VOC and on file at the Office of Business Resources ("official LNV map"). A maximum of ~~two (2)~~ one (1) licensed Late Night Vendors may vend from a legal parking spaces within Zone A at any one time. Only a licensed Late Night Vendors who ~~have~~ has been assigned to Zone A may vend in Zone A, and the vendors will be assigned to a this zone by seniority under Sec. 9.13(6)(n)4.b.
- b. Zone B: 400 Block of West Gilman. Zone B is located on the south side of the street in the 400 block of West Gilman Street, near University Avenue, as shown on the official LNV map. A maximum of ~~two (2)~~ one (1) licensed Late Night Vendors may vend from a legal parking spaces within Zone B at any one time. Only a licensed Late Night Vendors who ~~have~~ has been assigned to Zone B may vend in Zone B, and a vendors will be assigned to a the zone by seniority under Sec. 9.13(6)(n)4.b."
