PREAMBLE

This project consists of removal and replacement of the existing island on Lien Rd. at Thierer Rd. to accommodate new sidewalk and cross walk installation. Upon approval, this public works contract provides means to construct the approved devices.

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

1. That the plans and specifications for Lien Road Traffic Calming Island be and are hereby approved.

2. That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for the required public works contract.
3. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to accept dedication of lands and/or easements from the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of the existing public fee title or easement rights-of-ways.
