### Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution awards the contract for the construction of City View Drive on the east side of Madison for improved neighborhood connectivity. In the adopted 2017 capital budget the project is established with \$3 million of funding via Special Assessments (MUNIS 10429). The total estimated cost of the project is \$1,074,610 with funding assigned to the associated agencies as follows:

Major Streets - \$614,620  
Stormwater Utility - \$442,090  
Sewer Utility - \$17,900
