Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for the CIPP rehab of large diameter storm sewer pipes at an estimated cost of \$250,000. Funding is provided by revenue bonds within the Sewer Utility's adopted 2017 capital budget. The Trenchless Sewer Rehabilitation program budgeted \$1.4 million for the rehabilitation of failing sewers in 2017.
