Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution authorizes the Board of Public Works to receive bids for Garver Feed Mill material hauling. The estimated cost is \$180,000. Resolution RES-17-00664 adopted on August 1, 2017, amended the Parks Division Capital Budget by adding \$1,600,000 in GO Borrowing for the environmental remediation and site restoration costs to close the environmental investigation of the Garver Feed Mill, and other necessary associated costs to complete the project (Munis project 17169). Funding is available in the project.
