The proposed resolution awards the contract for the Fire Station 10 Bathroom Remodel project. The project is planned within the Engineering Facilities Management adopted 2017 capital budget via the Fire Building Improvements program (MUNIS 10560). This program funds miscellaneous improvements to the City's thirteen fire stations. Funding for the project will be provided by GO borrowing and the anticipated cost is \$166,920.
