Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plans and specifications and authorizes the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for 2018 Parks Playground Replacements - Group 1. The total estimated cost of the project is \$155,000. The Parks Division 2018 Capital Budget includes \$1,345,000 for the Playground/Accessibility Improvements (Munis project 17436) funded by GO Borrowing (\$745,000), Impact Fees (\$565,000), and Donations (\$35,000). Funding is available in this project.



- 1) That the plans and specifications for 2018 Parks Playground Replacements Group 1, be and are hereby approved.
- That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for



public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
