The proposed resolution approves plans for the the Water Utility's 2018 CIPP Rehabilitation (Cured In Place Piping) at a total estimated cost of \$500,000. Funding is provided by revenue bonds and is budgeted within the Water Utility's 2018 capital budget within the Water Mains Replace Rehab and Improve Pipe Lining program; a total of \$1 million is budgeted in this program for 2018.

BE IT RESOLVED,
