The proposed resolution approves plans for the the Water Utility's 2018 CIPP Rehabilitation (Cured In Place Piping) at a total estimated cost of \$500,000. Funding is provided by revenue bonds and is budgeted within the Water Utility's 2018 capital budget wthihn the Water Mains Replace Rehab and Improve Pipe Lining program; a total of \$1 million is budgeted in this program for 2018.

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for CIPP Rehabilitation of Water Mains - 2018, be and are hereby approved.

- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
