Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution awards the contract for the Gilson Street and Pine Street reconstruction projects at a total estimated cost of \$1,121,470. The reconstruction of these streets are planned within the adopted 2018 capital budget via the Engineering Major Streets Reconstruction Streets capital program (MUNS 11180); \$14,83 million is budgeted for the program in 2018. The total estimated project cost assigned to the Engineering budget and associated utilities is as follows:

- Engineering Major Streets - \$450,510
- Stormwater Utility - \$29,530
- Sewer Utility - \$391,260
- Water Utility - \$250,170
