Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution awards the contract for the reconstruction of Glenview Drive, Joylynne Drive, and Woodlawn Drive at a total cost of \$2,286,740 million. The reconstruction of these streets are planned within the adopted 2018 capital budget via Engineering Major Streets Reconstruction Streets capital program (MUNIS 11650); \$14.83 million is budgeted for the program in 2018. The total project cost assigned to the Engineering budget and associated utilities is as follows:

Engineering Major Streets - \$687,940 Stormwater Utility - \$275,400 Sewer Utility - \$730,850 Water Utility - \$592,550
