Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution awards the contract for the North Prospect Avenue reconstruction project at a total cost of \$508,160. The reconstruction of this street is planned within the adopted 2018 capital budget via the Engineering Major Streets Reconstruction Streets capital program (MUNS 11181); \$14,83 million is budgeted for the program in 2018. The total estimated project cost assigned to the Engineering budget and associated utilities is as follows:

Major Streets - \$225,270 Stormwater Utility - \$10,230 Sewer Utility - \$97,760 Water Utility - \$174,900
