The proposed resolution approves the plans and specifications and authorizes receiving bids for construction and installation of a launch for kayaks, canoes, and other non-motorized boats along Starkweather Creek. The Community Development Division will provide up to \$35,000 of federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds to Engineering for a boat launch and other eligible projects along Starkweather Creek.

Engineering understands that use of these federal funds requires compliance with various HUD regulatory standards and mandates. Adopted RES-17-00851 (Legistar file 49065) authorized the use of up to \$120,000 of CDBG funds to implement neighborhood improvement projects that address objectives identified in the Darbo-Worthington-Starkweather Creek Neighborhood Plan.

BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1) That the plans and specifications for DWSC Starkweather Creek Improvements, be and are hereby approved.
- 2) That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project.
- 3) That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
