### Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution authorizes the award of Public Works Contract No. 8220, Warner Park Boat Launch Parking Lot Reconstruction. The total estimated cost of the project is \$807,820. The Parks Division 2018 Capital Budget includes \$1,360,000 for the Beach and Shoreline Improvements project (Munis 10605) funded by GO Borrowing (\$850,000), Impact Fees (\$500,000), and Donations (\$10,000). Funding is available in this project for the contract.
