The proposed resolution awards the contract for the construction phase of the Fleet Relocation facility project for the Fleet, Fire, Radio Shop space at Nakoosa Trail at a total cost of \$29,900,880. In addition to this contract for construction, the total cost for completing the project is anticipated to be \$30,351,075 as seen detailed in legistar file #55256.
