That said storm sewer improvements are hereby assigned to the Madison Storm Water Utility for ownership and maintenance and that the attached Schedule "A" representing the actual cost of construction of these improvements shall be reflected in the Madison Storm Water Utility's "Utility Plant In Service".

4. That the street improvements, **excluding the bituminous pavement**, on the following streets be and are hereby accepted:

- Levitan Lane from the west property line of Lot 700 to the east property line of Lot 698.
- Morning Mist Way from Summer Shine Drive to Levitan Lane.
- Summer Shine Drive from Willow Rock Road to the west property line of Lot 565
- · Willow Rock Road from Lien Road to Summer Shine Drive
- Rustin Pebble Lane from the west property line of Lot 554 to Morning Mist Way

The attached Schedule "A" representing the actual cost of construction of these improvements, which shall increase the street infrastructure value for Project No 11509 \$252,125.39 for a useful life of 40 years.
