WHEREAS, based on 2017 Census data, the Hispanic/Latinx population of the United States is 57.5 million, which represents 17.8% of our total population, making Hispanic/Latinx people the nation's largest ethnic or racial minority; and,

WHEREAS, Hispanic Heritage Month is one of enormous pride for Hispanics/Latinx living in the United States; and,

WHEREAS, Madison is fortunate to count among its population a dynamic Hispanic/Latinx community that plays an important role in our city's economy and society; and,

WHEREAS, we encourage all Madisonians to recognize and applaud the many contributions made by our

Hispanic/Latinx community to enhance the quality of life in our city,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Common Council recognize the month of September 15, 2019, through October 15, 2019, as Hispanic Heritage Month in the City of Madison; and,
