The proposed resolution authorizes awarding the contract for the Cured-In-Place Pipe (CIPP) Rehabilitation of Sanitary Sewers - 2020 at a total cost of \$922,100, including contingency. Sufficient budget authority for the proposed contract is available in the 2020 Adopted Capital Budget for the Sewer Utility, Trenchless Sewer Rehabilitation project (Munis 12755-83-173). No additional appropriation is required.
