The proposed resolution authorizes awarding the contract for the 2021 Citywide Installation of Sidewalk, Curb & Gutter, and Concrete Pavement Patches at a total estimated cost of \$366,640 including contingency. Funding for the project is available in the 2021 Adopted Capital Budget for Engineering, Sidewalk Program and Pavement Management (Munis projects 13267, 13253, and 13434). No additional appropriation is required.
