Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plan documents for the replacement of a generator at the State Street Capitol Garage. The expected cost of this replacement is \$180,000. The replacement will be funded by Parking Utility reserves via existing budget authority in Parking's Garage Lighting Replacement capital program. This capital program's most recent budget appropriation was from the 2019 Adopted Capital Budget. No additional appropriation required.

necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
