The proposed resolution approves plans and specifications and authorizes the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for 2022 Inclusive Playgrounds. The estimated project cost is \$960,000 which includes purchase of playground equipment by City of Madison. The Public Works contract (to install equipment & construct associated site work) is \$646,000. Funding is available in MUNIS project numbers 13934-51-130 and 13935-51-130.
