The proposed resolution recreates a Parking Community Outreach Specialist (CG18, R4) to a Public Information Officer 1 (CG18, R8). The annualized additional costs of this change are approximately \$14,000. Any additional costs would be accommodated within Parking's existing operating budget authority.

Title
