#### **Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution approves the use of Safe Routes Grants funding for installation of new sidewalk on Walter Street, Johns Street, Busse Street and Royster Avenue at an estimated cost of \$17,358. The Safe Routes Grants Program pays 50% of a property owner's sidewalk assessment where new sidewalk is installed on eligible projects. The 2022 Capital Budget for Engineering-Bicycle and Pedestrian has \$100,000 budgeted for the Safe Routes Grants program (MUNIS 11112). Funding for this program is from GO borrowing.

#### **Body**

The Common Council approved Plans, Specifications, and Schedule of Assessments for New Sidewalk Installation Assessment District - 2022 on March 29, 2022, File ID 70457, RES-22-003191. Safe Routes Grants funding will be applied to all properties within the project limits with new sidewalk installation and reduce the amount due for assessments by 50 percent for the installation of new sidewalk.
