### Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution authorizes an amendment to the existing contract (#8481) for engineering services for the total amount of \$4,880.00. The new contract as amended will total \$182,847.80. Authorized funding for \$4,880.00 is available in the 2022 Adopted Stormwater Utility Operating Budget for consulting services to support Citywide Flood Mitigation (MUNIS 12490-84-200-84000). No additional appropriation is required.

#### PREAMBLE

The City of Madison Engineering Division is proposing to conduct watershed and flood studies for the west and near west sides as a result of extreme rain events over the past several years. The City entered into an agreement with MSA Professional Services, Inc. for engineering services (RES-19-00519). The City Engineer requested additional engineering services and recommend that they be undertaken by MSA Professional Services, Inc. for the Greentree/McKenna Watershed Study as defined below:

1. Additional analysis of pre-flood mitigation conditions.
