Fiscal Note

The proposed resolution approves plans and seeks bids for work related to the Fairchild Building Improvement project. The estimated project cost is \$2,350,000. Approximately \$1,250,000 funding is available in the 2022 Adopted Capital Budget in project 11078. The remainder of funding required is in the 2023 Capital Budget request in the Fairchild Building project and the Energy Improvements program (Munis Project #10562). Any contract award would be contingent upon approval of the requisite funding in the 2023 Capital Budget.
