**Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution recreates four Housing Maintenance Worker positions to Maintenance Mechanic 1 positions within the Housing Operating Budget and reallocates the incumbents to the new positions. The 2022 cost is approximately \$9,500 and will be absorbed within CDA Housing’s operating budget. The estimated annual cost is \$14,100.
