### Fiscal Note

The 2023 Adopted Capital Budget includes a project for Troy Drive Railroad Bridge (Munis # 11868). The budget includes \$1,342,200 in GF GO Borrowing and \$3,068,800 in state sources for design and construction in 2023. The proposed resolution would authorize the City to accept a state grant and execute an agreement. No additional appropriation is required.

### Title

Authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an Agreement for a Freight Railroad Preservation Program Grant for the Troy Drive Railroad Bridge Reconstruction Project (State Project ID 0492-20-08) with the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation. (18th AD)

### Body

Engineering Division submitted an application for State funds under the State of Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) Freight Railroad Preservation Program (FRPP).

The project is to replace a railroad bridge over Troy Drive (State Railroad Structure # 259), and reconstruct Troy Drive to include street, curb & gutter, terrace and sidewalk on both sides. The project was awarded a state grant that will reimburse 80% of participating design & construction costs. Design and construction is scheduled for 2023-2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute an Agreement for a Freight Railroad Preservation Program Grant for the Troy Drive Railroad Bridge Reconstruction Project (State Project ID 0492-20-08) with the State of Wisconsin Department of

Transportation.
