Title

Approving Addendum No. 1 to Hill Valley Phase 1, Contract No. 9643 (District 1)

Body

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2025, the developer, VH Hill Valley, LLC, hereinafter the “Developer” had entered into a *Contract For the Construction of Public Improvements that will be Accepted by the City of Madison* hereinafter the “Contract” with the City of Madison, and;

WHEREAS, the Developer and the City have since mutually agreed to remove the requirement to purchase and install property boundary markers as described in item O. in Section II Supplemental Conditions of contract 9643.

WHEREAS, the Developer shall install fence under Hill Valley Phase 1 - Stormwater Management (contract 9645) per the specifications and details provided by Engineering stormwater staff to serve the development in Hill Valley Phase 1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVE:

1. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute Addendum No. 1 to Hill Valley Phase 1, Contract No. 9643, with VH Hill Valley, LLC.

2. That the revised plans and specifications for the public improvements necessary to serve this project are hereby approved.
3. That the developer is authorized to construct the public improvements in accordance with the terms of the Contract For the Construction of Public Improvements That Will be Accepted by the City of Madison at the sole cost of the developer.
4. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside of existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
5. The Common Council is approved to accept ownership of the improvements in the Maintenance Area if a maintenance agreement is executed and recorded as a condition of this contract.
