### **Title**

Commending and honoring the work of Rebecca Kasemeyer, City of Madison Arts Administrator.

### **Body**

Whereas, Rebecca Kasemeyer started her employment with the City on January 2, 2001 and her last official day of employment was July 14, 2006; and,

Whereas, during her tenure she was instrumental in taking the City's municipal arts program to a higher level; and,

Whereas, one of her greatest accomplishments was promoting the idea of "art in city buildings" by getting people to think about and integrating public art into a variety of public projects including:

- The gates at Goodman Pool
- The fountains on the Square
- The "Philosopher's Grove" at the top of State Street
- Leading the design competition for the State Street bus shelters
- The public space on State Street in front of Overture
- The sculpture outside the entrance to the new Water Utility Building
- The sculpture on Broadway at Bridge Road
