The proposed resolution assesses the final charges for the South Blount Street and Williamson Street Traffic Signal Assessment District. The district was authorized by RES-19-00191. The final project cost was \$42,248.92, including \$5,498.66 funded by the City share. Funding is available in the E Wilson, Williamson, and Blount Project (Munis #11944).
