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### **Fiscal Note**

The proposed resolution approves plans and seeks bids for a traffic signal installation at Henry Street & West Washington Avenue. The expected cost of the installation is \$200,000. Legistar file #69335, enacted 2/3/22, added \$250,000 in General Fund general obligation borrowing to Traffic Engineering's 2022 capital budget to fund this project. No additional appropriation required.

### **Title**

Approving plans and specifications and authorizing the Board of Public Works to advertise and receive bids for the Henry Street & West Washington Avenue traffic signal. (4<sup>th</sup> AD)

### **Body**

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Traffic Engineering Department has recommended the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Henry Street & West Washington Avenue at the February 10, 2021 Transportation Commission (legistar file 64055); and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Transportation Commission adopted the Traffic Engineering Departments Staff Recommendation report on February 10, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Madison Traffic Engineering Department has determined that the City of Madison shall pay 100% of the cost of the project (legistar 69335); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED

1. That the plans and specifications for the Henry Street & West Washington Avenue Traffic Signal project, be and are hereby approved; and
2. That the Board of Public Works be and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids for said project; and
3. That the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to sign and grant easements or right-of-way release or procurement documents, maintenance agreements or encroachment agreements, as necessary and grant or accept dedication of lands and/or easements from/to the Developer/Owner for public improvements located outside the existing public fee title or easement right-of-ways.
